TUITION & FEE SCHEDULE

2017 -2018 School Year

Solid Foundation Preparatory Academy labors to provide an excellent private academic program and endeavors to ensure affordability for the families who choose to attend the school. Listed below are the tuition and fees for the 2017-2018 school year.

Book and Material Fees (non-refundable)

(Due April 14, 2017)

Returning Students:

PreK3 – Kindergarten	\$150.00
1 st – 5 th Grade	\$200.00

New Students:

PreK3 – Kindergarten	\$200.00
1 st – 5 th Grade	\$250.00

Tuition for 2017 – 2018 School Year

Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month.

A \$50.00 late fee is assessed on the 6th day of the month.

All monthly payments will be through ACH withdrawal.

PreK3 – PreK4 (\$5,520)

\$4,968.00/yearly	(10% discount if paid in full by June 1, 2016)
\$2,622.00/per semester	(5% discount if paid ½ by June 1 st and ½ by December 1 st)
\$5,520.00/monthly	(12 payments of \$460.00 / 1 st payment due June 1 st)

Kindergarten – 5th Grade (\$5,160)

\$4,644.00/yearly	(10% discount if paid in full by June 1, 2016)
\$2,451.00/per semester	(5% discount if paid ½ by June 1 st and ½ by December 1 st)
\$5,160.00/monthly	(12 payments of \$430.00 / 1 st payment due June 1 st)

After-Care Fees: (After-Care hours are 4:15pm – 5:30pm)

\$25 weekly fee paid in advance	\$20 per week (2 nd child)
\$10 daily fee paid the day services are rendered	\$5 per day (2 nd child)

Other Fees:

Field Trip fees vary for each trip. The costs will range from (\$15.00 - \$60.00).

Latimer-Cooksey Arts and Cultural Foundation, the governing entity for Solid Foundation Preparatory Academy, endeavors to provide an excellent academic program at an affordable cost for families who prefer a private education for their children.

We offer discounts to families who have two or more children enrolled in the grades of Kindergarten through fifth grade or families who opt to pay tuition in full for the year or by the semester. These discounts are available to all students, however, only one discount may be applied per family.

We do our best to ensure all costs associated with a private education is at a minimum, however, we want each parent to understand that tuition only meets 80% of the school's budget. With that said, the foundation and the school depend on our SFPA families to contribute annually to help meet the additional 20% it needs to effectively operate this program.

When acceptance into the program is granted, it is understood that parents will assist the school in meeting its budget by raising at least \$800.00 per family. This asking may be accomplished by participating in the fundraisers such as Blue & Gold, the LCAC Annual Gala, A Brass and Sassy Affair, company match programs, and/or general donations.

It is our goal to ensure we honor our mission of providing a first rate academic program for our families. With the help of our SFPA families we are sure to make it happen.
