## From the Teachers....

As we prepare to go into the 4th Quarter, we want you to know that the momentum is going strong and will continue until the last day of school, May 11, 2017. Please keep the following things in mind and continue to remind your child of the items listed.

1. Remember to check the planner for homework assignments and sign it after reviewing it. Be sure to check over homework before the student turns it in for credit. Students in grades K through 5th will be expected to write their assignments in their planners. If items in the planner are not legible, contact the teacher for clarification.
2. Any classwork that is sent home incomplete, please make sure that it is completed and returned the next day. \*Homework must be completed in addition to classwork sent home.\*
3. Refill supplies as necessary. Some students are still coming to class without their pencils and other supplies needed.
4. Students should read at least 20 minutes a day. Any book, magazine, comic and/or newspaper are great reading sources.
5. Students should practice good posture when sitting at the table. We are working with the students on not leaning back in their chairs and sitting on their feet. This is also good practice for the assessments done in May.
6. Each morning remind the students to follow the school rules. Students must receive 90% of their stars in order to participate in the “special” activities at the end of the month and the quarter.
