Tuition & Fee Schedule for 2023-2024 School Year:

Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month. A \$50.00 late fee is assessed on the 3rd day of the month. Monthly payments can be made through ACH withdrawal.

PreK3 – PreK4 (\$5,760 yearly payment due on June 1, 2023

A monthly option is \$480.00 - (12 payments / 1st payment due June 1st)

Kindergarten – 5th Grade (\$4,800) yearly payment due on June 1, 2023

A monthly option is \$400.00 - (12 payments / 1st payment due June 1st)

Sibling Discount: 10% discount (\$4,320/yearly - \$360/monthly)

Partial scholarships may be available and will vary each year. To be considered for a partial scholarship, families must fill out a FACTS application which requires a processing fee. See the School Director for more information.

OverTime After-Care Fees:

(After-Care hours are 4:00pm – 5:30pm) \$50/week - \$40/week each additional child

Other Fees: Art/Recital/Instrument (\$100), Field Trip and Lunch fees vary from (\$15.00 - \$65.00).

I further understand that if my child withdraws from school for any reason on or after June 1, 2023, I am still responsible for the full tuition for the entire 2023-2024 school year.

I understand that Solid Foundation Preparatory Arts Academy will pursue all available collection methods for unpaid bills, and the expenses of such collections, including but not limited to attorney fees, will be added to the unpaid balance.

I understand that all school bills must be paid in full before student records/transcripts will be released.

I agree to make no claim for refunds of tuition, fees, or other charges on account of extended absence or dismissal of the student.

Upon submitting the enrollment contract, I will schedule a parent meeting with the School Director to be held in the months of February 2023 and March 2023.

I further agree to abide by all rules, regulations, and disciplinary procedures deemed necessary for the proper operation of the school.

I also understand that my child/legal dependent will be held accountable by these same rules, regulations, and procedures, as they are contained in the annual Parent/Student Handbook.
